Renee has experience in Construction, PR, Residential Care, Mental Health and Aged Care and is Qualified as an Ontological Coach.

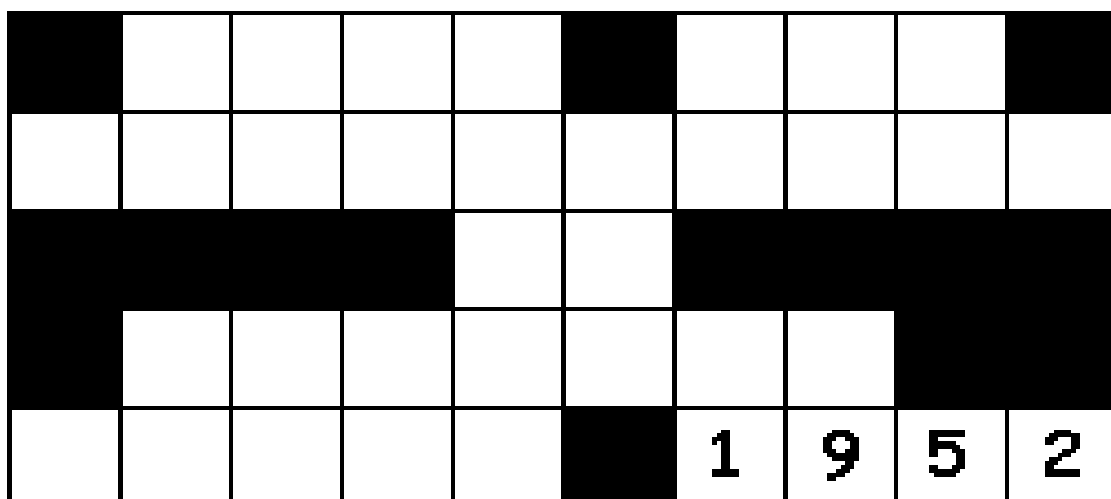
In 2015 she won the ACSWA Excellence award in the Trainee Category.

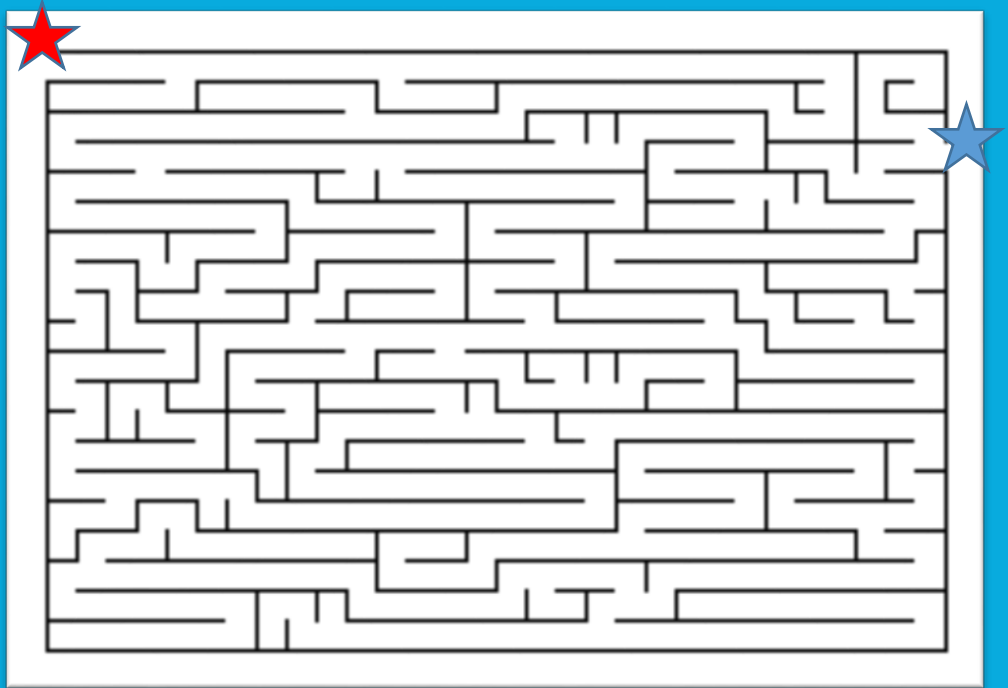
